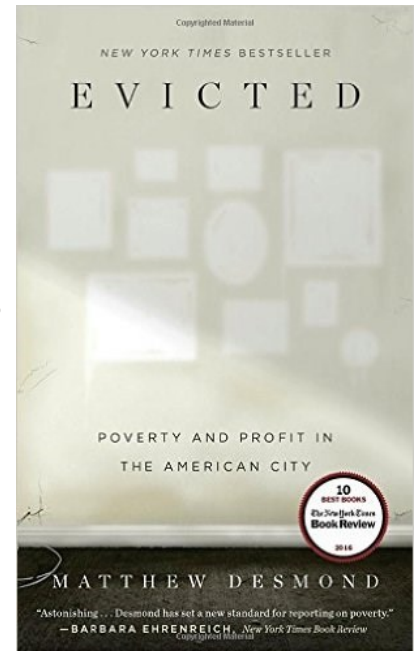

Join UWEC Associate Professor of Sociology and Communications Peter Hart-Brinson and journalist Julian Emerson as they lead a discussion on homelessness and its far-reaching impact.

Hart-Brinson will kick off the evening with a discussion of the Pulitzer Prize winning book *Evicted* by Matthew Desmond which follows eight families in Milwaukee as they struggle to keep a roof over their heads. *Evicted* transforms our understanding of poverty and economic exploitation while providing fresh ideas for solving one of 21st-century America's most devastating problems.

Emerson will round out the evening, guiding us in a discussion on homelessness in the Chippewa Valley and sharing his experiences during research for an in-depth series of articles on homeless living conditions through harsh Wisconsin winters.
